

Subject:-

Principles for promotion and fixation of seniority of Ministerial Officers in the Offices of heads of Departments.

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Department Memo No. 14030/Gen., dt. 4.5.88 on the aforementioned subject and to say that the requirement of passing the Preliminary and Final Accounts Examinations in respect of Junior and Senior Assts. for promotion to the post of senior Asst. and Section Officer, Level-II respectively was kept in abeyance with a view to providing chances to the persons concerned to pass the said examinations.

The Union Heads of Departments Section Officers Association and Orissa Heads of Department Ministerial Service Association have been demanding for exemption from passing such Accounts Examinations. This has been carefully considered by Government. Since knowledge in accounts on the part of Assistants working in the Offices of the Heads of Departments is immensely helpful to the administration, Government are not inclined to do away with this provision. Government have, however, been pleased to order that the persons who are due to retire within a period of three years with effect from 1.6.1990 shall be exempted from passing the examinations in question. Others should pass the required Account examination during the extended period ending on 24.9.90 to qualify themselves for promotion to higher posts.
