No. OSSC-31/98. 19439 /Gen., In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Orissa is pleased to make the following rules to amend the Orissa Staff Selection Commission Rules, 1993, namely :-

1. (1) These rules may be called the Orissa Staff Selection Commission (Amendment) Rules, 1998.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Orissa Gazette.
2. In the Orissa Staff Selection Commission Rules, 1993 (hereinafter referred to as "the said rules"), in clause (g) of rule 2, for the words "Secretary-cum-Controller of Examinations", the words "Secretary of the Commission" shall be substituted.
3. In the said rules, in rule 3, -
 - (i) for sub rule (6), the following sub-rule shall be substituted, namely :-

"(6) The Commission shall function under the Administrative Control of the General Administration Department";
 - (ii) "for sub-rule (10), the following sub-rule shall be substituted, namely :-

"(10) the Chairman shall nominate expert(s) in particular discipline/trade for each selection wherever necessary from among the State Government Officers, Professors of the Universities of the State or academicians, or Officers of Government of India or of other States or of Public Sector Undertakings whether in service or retired and from among other eminent persons having specialised knowledge in the particular discipline/trade", and

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(iii) in sub-rule (11), for the words " in consultation with the Chairman" the words "under the supervision of the Chairman" shall be substituted.

4. In the said rules, for clause (c) excluding the proviso thereto of sub-rule (1) of rule 7, the following clause shall be substituted, namely :-
"(c) (i) His age shall not be less than the minimum age limit as prescribed under rule 52-A of the Orissa Service Code on the 1st day of January of the year in which recruitment is held, and his age shall not be more than the upper age limit as prescribed in the Orissa Civil Service (Fixation of Upper Age Limit) Rules, 1989".
5. In the said rules, in sub-rule (2) of rule 11, after the word "examination" appearing at the end, the words "and the same shall be published sufficiently ahead in two leading local newspapers" shall be added.
6. In the said rules, in sub-rule (3) of rule 12, after the words "the local educational buildings" the words "or the buildings belonging to the State Government/Public Sector Undertakings or the like" shall be inserted.
7. In the said rules, for rule 13 the following rule shall be substituted, namely :-
"13. The Commission shall conduct the recruitment examination as per the syllabus and the pattern of examination as may be decided by them in consultation with the concerned Administrative Department of the State Government. However, while fixing up the marks for the oral test/interview/personality test, the commission and Administrative Department shall ensure that the marks allotted to such oral test/interview/personality test, shall not exceed 12.2% of the total marks allotted.

8. In the said rules, in sub-rule (2) of rule, 15 after the words "in the notice board of the Commission" the words "and in two leading local newspapers" shall be added.

9. In the said rules, for Schedule-II, the following SCHEDULE shall be substituted, namely :-
