R E S O L U T I O N

Government of Orissa in the erstwhile Welfare Department Resolution No.35758/OBC/75/94/W., dated 8th December, 1994 have prescribed 27% of reservation in Civil posts and services under the State, for Socially and Educationally Backward Classes (S&EBC) in initial/direct recruitment. It has come to the notice of Government that in many cases the number of selected candidates is found to be less than the number of vacancies reserved for the S&EBC category. The Administrative Departments are seeking clarification as to whether under such eventualities the unfilled vacancies shall be carried forward to the subsequent years.

2. After careful consideration, Government have been pleased to prescribe the following guidelines with a view to ensuring adequate representation of the S&EBC candidates in Civil posts and Services under the State in initial/direct recruitments.

- a) If in any recruitment year (the calendar year during which recruitment is actually made) the number of candidates selected for any post(s)/Service(s) is less than the number of vacancies reserved for the Socially and Educationally Backward Classes, the said unfilled vacancies may be filled up by holding fresh recruitment(s) (special recruitment drive) only from the candidates belonging to the S&EBC category.
- b) In case, suitable S&EBC candidates are still not available, after exhausting special recruitment(s) drive the remaining unfilled vacancies shall be filled up by unreserved candidates, after "dereserving" the vacancies. But the vacancies so dereserved shall be carried forward to subsequent 3(three) years of recruitment.

- c) Dereservation of the vacancies shall be made by the appointing Authority, with the prior approval of the next higher authority.
- d) After such dereservation is made, the appointing authority shall intimate the fact to the District Collector concerned in case of dereservation of vacancies of any district office and in case of de-reservation of vacancies of offices of the Heads of Department or Administrative Departments of Government to the Minority and Backward Classes Welfare Department alongwith a certificate to the effect that "dereservation has been made only after following due procedure and conducting special recruitment drive".
- e) The unfilled backlog and/or carried forward vacancies shall be treated as a separate and distinct group and shall not be considered together with the reserved vacancies of the year in which they are being filled up.
- f) The relative seniority of the candidates recruited through a special recruitment drive shall be determined according to their position assigned in the select list and such candidates shall take rank just below the successful candidates of the preceding general recruitment examination appointed in a particular year.

This will come into force from the date of issue of this Resolution.

ORDER :- Ordered that the Resolution be published in the extraordinary issue of Orissa Gazettee and copies thereof be sent to all Departments of Government/All Heads of Department/s/All Collectors.






