Subject:- Verification of character and antecedents
of candidates for employment under the central
Government.

Sir,

I am directed to say that the manner
of verification of character and antecedents of
candidates for employment under the Central Government
was communicated to you in this Department letter
No.9073(15) Gen; dated the 25th June, 1958. In the
meantime the Government of India in their letter
No.F3/16/58-Est.(B), dated the 9th April, 1959 (copy
enclosed for reference) have decided that in case
of favourable report of the character and antecedents
of a candidate for employment under them the District
Superintendent of Police should forward his report
direct to the D.I.G.,C.I.D. of Police by passing
the District Magistrate concerned, but where the
report is unfavourable the usual procedure of
forwarding the report to the D.I.G.,C.I.D. through
the concerned District Magistrate should be followed.

I am therefore to request that the
procedure now decided by the Government of India
may be followed for verification of character and
antecedents of candidates for employment under the
Central Government only and this may be brought to
the notice of the District Superintendents of Police
for their information and guidance. The procedure
for verification of character and antecedents of
State Government employees will continue to be the
same as laid down in Political and Services Department
memo No.2R-1-40/57-11852(74) Gen., dated 14.9.57.
