In the erstwhile Labour, Employment & Housing Department Resolution No.17188 dated 9.9.1976 rehabilitation assistance to the families of employees who suffers permanently incapacitated or death while in service were allowed. General Administration Department in their U.D.I dated 30.12.86 have observed that the Government Orders regarding rehabilitation assistance have no retrospective effect (UOI No.7612 dt.10.12.86 of the Education and Youth Services Department). However, the Labour and Employment Department in a similar case have allowed extension of rehabilitation benefits to a deceased employee's son as a special case vide U.O.I.No.7734 dated 17.12.86 of the Education and Youth Services Department.

Making out all special cases giving retrospective effect to this Resolution creates a lot of administrative problems since every petitioner prays to treat his case as a special one. It is felt desirable that such precedents may be declared to be inapplicable in all future cases. Education and Youth Services Department are taking action as outlined above in all such cases and no special cases for relaxation are being entertained.
