Since the State is running with acute shortage of doctors, it became invariably necessary to take additional measures to fill up the existing 3278 nos. of vacancies in the rank of Group-A (JB) of OMHS Cadre in order to overcome the above difficulties and to provide proper health care to the people of the State. Hence, after careful consideration the Government have been pleased to allow one time relaxation to the provisions under Rule-6 of OMHS Cadre Rules, 2017 to the following extent by invoking the provision of Rule-16 of the said Rules for the recruitment of regular Medical Officers (Assistant Surgeons) in the rank of Group-A (Junior Branch) of the Odisha Medical & Health Services cadre through OPSC for the year 2019-20.

1. Additional weightage of 3% of extra marks for each completed year of service subject to a maximum of 15% of total marks to Adhoc and Contractual doctors in the recruitment through OPSC.
2. The qualifying marks will be decided by the OPSC while recommending the required number of doctors.
3. The career marking evaluation will not be done.
4. The written examination to be conducted by OPSC will be done online/ Optical Mark Recognition (OMR) method.

This has also been duly concurred in by the Odisha Public Service Commission vide their letter No. 6788 dated. 24.10.2019.
