Sub: Fixation of Headquarters of Government
servant during the period of suspension.

The undersigned is directed to invite a reference to Home Department memo No. 3032(68)/A dated 28.2.1956, on the subject noted above and to say that a question arose whether an authority competent to order the suspension of an official has the power to prescribe his headquarters during the period of suspension. The following decisions have been taken after the matter has been carefully examined.

2. An Officer under suspension is regarded as subject to all other conditions of service applicable generally to Government servants and cannot leave the station without prior permission. As such the headquarters of a Government servant should normally be assumed to be his last place of duty. However, where an individual under suspension requests for a change of headquarters there is no objection to a competent authority changing the headquarters if is satisfied that such a course will not put Government to any extra expenditure like grant of T.A. etc. or other complications.

3. The above instructions may please be communicated to all subordinate Offices and Officers for their guidance.
