~~In the erstwhile Political and Services Department Order No. 1000 dtd. 27.10.1962, instructions were issued to the effect that before placing a Govt. servant under suspension on vigilance report, an opportunity should be given to him to explain his conduct within a reasonable period and, on receipt of such explanation, decision to place the officer under suspension will be taken.~~

2. But Sub-rules (i) & (ii) of the Orissa Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1962 clearly envisage the circumstances in which a Govt. servant can be placed under suspension. In view of the provisions contained in these rules, there is no special justification for calling for the explanation of an officer before consideration to place him under suspension on the basis of vigilance report.

3. Accordingly, Government, after careful consideration, do hereby withdraw the afore-mentioned Political and Services Department Order No. 1000 dtd. 27.10.1962.
