Rehabilitation assistance to the families of deceased or permanently disabled Govt. servants who die or suffer the disability while in Government service - clarification in the matter of appointment.

Instructions were issued in General Administration Department Resolution No.21684/Gen., dt.9.9.82 to amend the relevant recruitment rules for extending the concessions of rehabilitation assistance to all Class-III posts / services. It was also made clear subsequently that the amendment to the recruitment rules should be made with effect from the date of issue of the Resolution. But it is not known, if the Departments of Government have taken any such steps in this regard.

So far as the O.M.S. (Method of Recruitment to the posts of Junior Assistants in the Offices of Heads of Departments) Rules, 1975 and O.M.S. (Method of recruitment to the posts of Junior Clerks in the District Offices) Rules, 1982 are concerned, it is clarified that, Rule-14 of O.M.S. Rules, 1975 and Rule-13 of the O.M.S. Rules, 1982, which provide for relaxation in public interest, cover all such cases. The rehabilitation scheme was introduced as a matter of Government policy. It goes without saying that implementation of Government policy is in public interest.

Appointment to the posts of Junior Assts/ Junior Clerks under the scheme of rehabilitation assistance can therefore, be given in the offices of Heads of Departments and District Offices and Offices sub-ordinate thereto by following the procedure laid down under Rule-14 of the OMS Rules, 1975 and Rule-13 of the OMS Rules, 1982.

The seniority of the candidates so appointed will be determined under Rule-14 of the OMS Rules, 1982 and under proviso to Rule-14 of the OMS Rules, 1975.
