No. 16216—Arbo. / G.-30/2003-G.A.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Orissa is pleased to make the following rules further to amend the Recruitment and Conditions of Service of Mulia, Mali and Grafter (working under Arboriculture Organisation of General Administration Department) Rules, 1990, namely :—

1. (1) These rules may be called the Recruitment and Conditions of Service of Mulia, Mali and Grafter (working under Arboriculture Organisation of the General Administration Department) Amendment Rules, 2004.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the *Orissa Gazette*.

2. In the Recruitment and Conditions of Service of Mulia, Mali and Grafter (working under Arboriculture Organisation of General Administration Department) Rules, 1990 (hereinafter referred to as the said rules), for the word "Mulia", wherever it occurs including in the short title, the words 'Sahakari Mali' shall be substituted.

3. In the said rules, for the words and numerals "Class-IV or Class-III", wherever they occur, the words and letters 'Group-D' and Group-C shall respectively be substituted.

4. In the said rules, for Clause (d) of sub-rule (i) of rule 6, the following clause shall be substituted, namely :—

"not be less than twenty-one years and not more than thirty-two years of age on the first day of April of the year in which recruitment is made :

Provided that the upper age limit shall be relaxed by five years in case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Women, by three years in case of candidates belonging to Socially and Educationally Backward classes and ten years in case of physically handicapped persons and to such extent in case of candidates of such categories as Government may by rules specify from time to times".
