NOTIFICATION

The 13th June 1988

S. R. O. No. 412/88—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Orissa hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Orissa Ministerial Service (Method of Recruitment and Conditions of Service of Junior Assistants in the Offices of the Departments of Secretariat Rules., 1951, namely:—

1. (1) These rules may be called the Orissa Ministerial Service (Method of Recruitment and Conditions of Service of Junior Assistants in the Offices of the Departments of Secretariat) (Amendment) Rules, 1988.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the *Orissa Gazette*.

2. In the Orissa Ministerial Service (Method of Recruitment and Condition of Service of Junior Assistants in the Offices of the Departments of Secretariat) Rules, 1951, in Rule 22—

(i) the first paragraph shall be numbered as sub-rule (1) ;

(ii) for the second paragraph the following sub-rule shall be substituted, namely :—

“(2) Except in the case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes, no application shall be considered unless it is accompanied by necessary fees for application and examination in the shape of crossed Postal Orders in favour of Special Secretary, Orissa Public Service Commission which shall be such as may be prescribed by the Commission from time to time with the approval of the Government. The fees once paid shall not ordinarily be refunded.

(iii) Note I below sub-rule (2) shall be omitted.
