Subject:- Grant of permission to Government servants to appear at the I.A., I.Com., B.A. (Pass), and B.Com. examinations privately.

The undersigned is directed to say that in this Department memo No. 2222(74) Gen., dated 23.2.61 it has been laid down that ~~and~~ Government servants may be allowed to appear privately at I.A., I.Com., B.A. and B.Com. examinations irrespective of the duration of their services under Government and on the condition that their legitimate duties do not suffer thereby.

This Government Order, however, does not describe the authority who is to grant necessary permission to Government servant for appearing privately in the above examinations. As a result there have been a number of references to Government on this subject.

Government would like to make it clear that it would not be necessary to obtain orders of the Administrative Department for permitting a Government employee to appear privately at an examination as contemplated in the G.O. under reference. The Head of Department may give such permission to an officer in respect of whom he is the appointing authority but before granting the permission he should ensure that the legitimate work in the office does not suffer and the employee fulfills the condition prescribed by Government from time to time. Only cases of officers in respect of which Government are the appointing authority shall be referred to the administrative Department.

The provisions of existing Government orders regarding permission to be granted by Administrative Departments to Government servants for prosecution of study in colleges for academic degrees will, however, remain unaffected.
