Instruction on re-employment of  
Government Servants.

Sir,

I am directed to say that Cabinet in their meeting dated 3.9.91 while discussing on regularisation of overstaya period in service of some of the Government servants through re-employment had taken a decision that these proposals affecting service conditions of individual Government Servants such as creation of posts and ante-dating promotion, etc in compliance with Court's Orders or proposals on treatment of period of overstay in service as re-employment need not be brought to the Cabinet and that such case should be decided under the orders of the Chief Minister. This decision of Cabinet was communicated to all Departments vide this Department letter No. 28560/dt.13.11.91.

Further, Cabinet in their meeting held on 24.3.92 while discussing on re-employment of Government Servants on contract basis observed that in future, all proposals on re-employment of Government servants, except in the cases indicated in this Department letter under reference, should be referred to the Council/Cabinet for their decision. Such proposals should not be placed before the Chief Minister for anticipating the approval of the Cabinet.
