#### NOTIFICATION

The 18th June 1998

No. 14429—SC.-H-2/98-Gen.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Orissa is pleased to make the following rules to amend the Orissa Ministerial Services (Method of Recruitment and Conditions of Service of Assistants and Section Officers in the Offices of the Heads of Departments) Rules, 1994.

1. (1) These rules may be called the Orissa Ministerial Services (Method of Recruitment and Conditions of Service of Assistants and Section Officers in the Offices of the Heads of Departments) Amendment Rules, 1998.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the *Orissa Gazette*.

2. In the Orissa Ministerial Services (Method of Recruitment and Conditions of Services of Assistants and Section Officers in the Offices of the Heads of Departments), Rules 1994 (hereinafter referred to as the said rules), for sub-rule (1) of rule 11, the following sub-rule shall be substituted, namely:—

“(1) The examination shall be conducted on the following subjects carrying marks as shown against each:—

Subject	Marks
Objective Language	100
Arithmetics	100
General Knowledge	100
<b>Total</b>	<b>300</b>

3. In the said rules for serial numbers '1' and '3' of APPENDIX II the following serials shall be respectively be substituted, namely:—

“ (3) Arithmetics (Matriculation Standard)—3 hours duration ... 100 marks

(Under this, there will be a series of questions in Practical Mathematics required for day to day use. The questions would be such as to test candidate's ability to work out fractions, decimals, percentage, average, simple and compound interest, rates and taxes, Insurance, Profit and Loss, Mixture, Partnership Problems on time and work and time and distance )”.
