R E S O L U T I O N

Sub :- Re-employment of retired Government servants.

In the Political & Services Department Resolution No.3642-Gen., dated 19th/20th February, 1968, Government decided not to grant extension of service to any Government servant beyond the age of compulsory retirement and not to re-employ retired Government servants except with the approval of the Cabinet. In the Political & Services Department Resolution No.9923-Gen., dated the 26th June, 1972 a complete ban was imposed on re-employment and it was decided that there should be no re-employment of any Government Servant after the age of compulsory retirement on any account.

2. Government have now reviewed the matter in the context of continuing acute shortage of manpower in almost all Departments with resultant deleterious effect on implementation of Plan schemes and in modification of the Political & Services Department Resolution referred to above they have been pleased to decide that with a view to removing this scarcity of personnel during the Sixth Five Year Plan period retired Government servants could be re-employed upto the age of 60 years provided they were physically fit and mentally alert.

ORDER - Ordered that this Resolution should be published in the Orissa Gazette. Ordered also that copies of the resolution be forwarded to all Departments of Government/All Heads of Departments/All District and Session Judges/All District Offices/ Secretary to the Governor/Secretary, Orissa Public Service Commission/Secretary, Orissa Legislative Assembly/Registrar, Orissa High Court/Director of Printing, Stationery and Publication, Orissa Cuttack/Accountant General, Orissa for information and necessary action.
