NOTIFICATION

No. 19174-2R/1-24/99-Gen.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309, of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Orissa is pleased to make the following rule to amend the Orissa *ex-Servicemen* (Recruitment to State Civil Services and Posts) Rule, 1985, namely :—

1. (1) This rule may be called the Orissa *ex-Servicemen* (Recruitment to State Civil Services and Posts) Amendment Rule, 1999.

(2) It shall come into force on the date of its publication in the *Orissa Gazette*.

2. In the Orissa *ex-Servicemen* (Recruitment to State Civil Services and Posts) Rules, 1985 after Clause (b) of Sub-rule (2) of rule 6, the following new clause shall be inserted, namely :—

“(C) For appointment to any reserved vacancy in Class III (Group-C) Posts an *ex-Servicemen*, having matriculation qualification or who has obtained the Indian Army Special Certificate of Education or the corresponding certificate in the Navy or the Air Force and has put in not less than 15 years of Service in the Armed Forces of the Union may be considered eligible for appointment to the posts for which the essential educational qualification prescribed is graduation”.

OFFICE ORDER

No. 41145—OE(G/4)147/98-A—Whereas disciplinary proceedings was drawn up against the Librarian, Smt. Moortimatee Samantaray in this Department Memo No. 49107, dated the 21st September 1998, for her disobedience of Government Orders, violation of Government Servants Conduct Rules and suppression of facts, she was directed to submit her statement of defence against the charges within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of the aforesaid Memo. After receipt of the charges she has submitted her statement of defence on the 12th October 1998.

After careful consideration of her statement of defence and enquiry into relevant records by the appointing authority the second show cause notice was issued to her in this Department Memo. No. 21259, dated the 16th April 1999 with an information that the disciplinary authority has been pleased to decide to dismiss her from Government service under Rule 15 of O. C. S. (C. C. A.) Rules, 1962.

After careful consideration of her explanation on second show cause notice and enquiry into relevant records the Disciplinary Authority has been pleased to dismiss her from Government service. Accordingly in pursuance of the provisions contained in Rule 13 (ix) read with rule 18 (ii) of the O. C. S. (C. C. A.) Rules, 1962 and under proviso (b) to Article 311 (2) of the Constitution Smt. Moortimatee Samantaray is dismissed from Government service with immediate effect.
