Conversion of temporary posts into
permanent ones.

The undersigned is directed to say that in Political and Services Department resolution No. 10295-Gen., dated 1.3.63 orders of Government were conveyed to the effect that all temporary posts except those that are connected with purely temporary schemes or whose permanent retention would not be justified for other reasons can be treated to have qualified for permanency as and when they complete the period of 3 years. As a result of the special drive launched by the Committee on permanency constituted in the P & S Department quite a large number of temporary posts were recently made permanent. It has now come to the notice of Government after test check conducted in some offices that there are still a large number of temporary posts which have not been made permanent.

Since non-conversion of temporary posts into permanent ones creates dis-satisfaction among the employees for which complaints are received from different service Associations and as the Auditor General of India has been pressing from time to time for conversion of temporary posts into permanent ones, it is requested that early steps may kindly be taken to declare all eligible temporary posts permanent.
