**NOTIFICATION**

No. 43676—2R/1-12/2000-Gen.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Orissa is pleased to make the following rules further to amend the Orissa Civil Services (Combined Competitive Recruitment Examination) Rules, 1991, namely :—

1. (1) These rules may be called the Orissa Civil Services (Combined Competitive Recruitment Examination) Amendment Rules, 2000.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the *Orissa Gazette*.

2. In the Orissa Civil Services (Combined Competitive Recruitment Examination) Rules, 1991 for rule 13, the following rule shall be substituted, namely :—

13. Every candidate appearing at the examination, if he is otherwise eligible, shall be permitted four attempts at the examination irrespective of the number of attempts he has availed of at the Orissa Administrative Service and other examinations of previous years held prior to the commencement of these rules :

Provided that—(i) nothing herein shall apply in the case of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe candidates.

(ii) candidates belonging to the socially and educationally backward classes shall be permitted seven such attempts and

(iii) a candidate who has been selected for appointment to any of the Posts or Services mentioned under Category-II in column (2) of Schedule-I may, subject to his eligibility, be allowed to compete again for any Class-II Service or Services mentioned under Category-I in column (2) of the said Schedule.

NOTE—Notwithstanding the disqualification or cancellation of candidature, the fact of appearance of the candidate at the examination will count as an attempt.
