Sub: Issue of clarification regarding providing  
employment under R.A.Scheme.

Sir,

In inviting a reference to your L.No.5775, dated 29.8.96 on the subject noted above I am directed to say that the membership of the family of an employee, who dies while in service or who retires on the ground of permanent incapacitation, is decided on the basis of the status of the family concerned on the very day of death or invalid retirement for the purpose of rehabilitation assistance scheme as per Rule 2(b) of G.C.S.(R.A.) Rules 1990. It means that the persons who were not separated from the family as per procedure established by law on or before the date of death or retirement of the Government servant concerned, cannot be said to have been separated from the family for the purpose of determination of family members under the G.C.S.(R.A.) Rules, 1990 as amended up-to-date. Hence any separation or adoption deed executed and registered after the date of death or invalid retirement of an employee cannot be taken into consideration for the purpose of providing employment under R.A.Scheme to any one of his family members.
