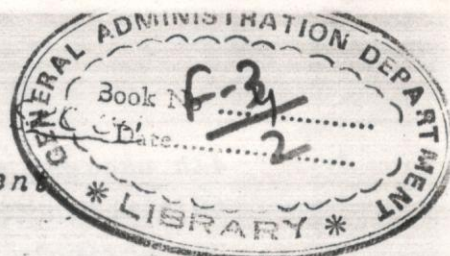

MEMORANDUM

Bhubaneswar dated the 15<sup>th</sup> Feb. 1984

Sub:-

Revision of roster points for physically handicapped persons.

In para 7 of the General Administration Department Resolution No.15338/Gen. dated 4.5.1981, a roster has been prescribed for giving the benefit of reservation to physically handicapped persons in Class-III and Class-IV posts/Services under the State Government and Public Sector Undertakings. According to this, the 34th vacancy occurring in a particular recruitment year is to be earmarked for the blind, the 67th vacancy and 100th vacancy for the deaf and the orthopaedically handicapped persons respectively in a cycle of 100 vacancies. Subsequently in the G. A. Department resolution No.16189/Gen. dated 16.7.82, the reservation made in Class-I, II and Class-IV posts has been extended to gazetted posts in Class-II and posts and services specially declared as gazetted to which direct recruitment is made and accordingly the said roster is also applicable to Class-II and specially declared gazetted posts. The existing roster arrangement has been made in the light of the decision of Government of India. In the context of the need for speedy rehabilitation of the physically handicapped, particularly the blind, the Government of India have reviewed the roster points for the posts and services under them and have intimated that 3rd vacancy occurring in a particular recruitment year should be earmarked for the blind and 37th and 70th vacancies reserved for the deaf and orthopaedically handicapped respectively in a cycle of 100 vacancies. In case any of these vacancies happens to be reserved for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes or Ex-Servicemen the next clear vacancy should be reserved for physically handicapped persons. Consequent upon this revision of roster points by the Government of India in the Central Government posts and services, it is proposed that in the roster of vacancies for posts and services under the State Government and Public Sector Undertakings, the

4th vacancy should be reserved for the blind and 34th and 69th vacancies for deaf and orthopaedically handicapped respectively. In case any of these vacancies happens to be reserved for the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe or Ex-Servicemen, the next clear available vacancy should be reserved for the physically handicapped persons. This proposal has been agreed to by Harijan and Tribal Welfare and Community Development and Rural Reconstruction Departments.

2. The memorandum is placed before the Cabinet for favour of consideration and approval.
