OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Bhubaneswar, dated the 22nd January, 1978

No. SC/6-70/77 1525 /Gen., In Political & Services Department Office Memorandum No. 12762/Gen., dated 1-10-1962 certain terms and conditions as well as service benefits were prescribed for the State Government Servants who are spared to work under the Government of India undertakings established in the Country. The provisions of this Office Memorandum are not applicable to State Government servants deputed to work under the State Government undertakings and other Corporations established in the State.

The question of enlarging the scope of this Office Memorandum with a view to confer service benefits contained therein to State Government servants deputed to work under State Government undertakings and other statutory Corporations had been under consideration of Government for some time past. A large number statutory Corporations and other State Government undertakings have been constituted in the State in the recent past and many Government servants who are desirous of working under these undertakings feel reluctant to do so because of the uncertainty to their service conditions in the absence of prescribed rules.

The State Government after careful consideration of the issue have been pleased to decide that the terms and conditions and other service benefits prescribed under the aforesaid Office Memorandum shall also apply to the State Government servants who are spared to work under the statutory Corporations or other State Government undertakings constituted in the State.

This Office Memorandum will take effect from 1st October, 1962.
