
Sub: Permanency of temporary posts.

Government in Political and Services Department Resolution No. 10295 Gen., dated 17.7.63 decided that all temporary posts except those that are connected with purely temporary schemes or whose permanent retention would not be justified for other reasons should be treated to have qualified for permanency as and when they complete the period of 3 years and the Departments of Government/Heads of Departments etc were requested to take all possible steps to convert all such temporary posts in their Departments and offices subordinate to them into permanent ones and complete that work positively by the 30th December, 1963.

It has been brought to the notice of Government that the work of making temporary posts permanent has not made substantial progress so far, although Government desired the work to be completed by 30.12.1963 and many Government servants have been continuing on temporary basis for a long time.

I am therefore, to request that the work relating to making all eligible temporary posts permanent should now be completed by 15.4.1965 and a compliance report submitted to the P & S Department by 19.4.1965 positively without waiting for any decision to be taken in this regard by the Committee constituted in P & S Department Memo No. 4187-Gen., dated 17.3.1964 inasmuch as, as indicated in para 5 of the said memorandum the Committee will only review the implementation of the order issued for making the temporary posts permanent as recommended by the Pay Committee and submit a report to Government with their suggestions about the requirement of staff of each Department and Offices subordinate to it., the manner of absorption of temporary staff employed in purely temporary schemes and other measures to improve the efficiency of the staff.
