Sub: Passing in departmental examinations.

...

The undersigned is directed to say that it has come to the notice of Government that in some instances Government servants do not pass the departmental examinations in time and approach Government for exemption from passing the examination on the ground that they are on the verge of retirement and non-confirmation in the post they held at the time of retirement on the ground of not passing the Departmental examination will deprive them from getting pension at a higher rate. The Departments also recommend such cases to Government for exemption. Government are averse to the grant of such exemptions. In the context of emphasis on knowledge in accounts it is incumbent that every officer should pass the accounts examination. No exemption will be granted to any person from passing the departmental examinations, except to the extent provided for in the rules.
