
Sub : Clarification on Issue of Distress Certificate in case of appointment under  
Rehabilitation assistance Scheme.

No. 223 dt. 27.01.2007

Sir

I am directed to say on the above subject that, when a Distress Certificate is issued for consideration of appointment under Rehabilitation Assistance Scheme, it shows the distress condition of the total family, not the distress condition of any particular member of the family. It may be clarified from the appointing authority what action was taken on the distress Certificate earlier issued. Appointment is made to a member of the family of the deceased as per preference specified in rule 2(b) of the OCS (RA) Rules, 1990. What is the necessity of the son of the deceased to apply when his mother has applied earlier and a distress certificate issued.
