Sub: ***Promotion of Group-"D" employees of Secretariat to the rank of Jr. Assistant.***

The undersigned is directed to invite reference to their letter No.12153/CC dt.18.3.04 on the above subject and say that it has been decided in consultation with the Finance Department that five percent vacant posts of Junior Assistant meant for promotion of Group-"D" employees can not be treated as base level posts and hence there is no restriction for filling of these 5% vacancies by way of promotion. The five per cent vacancies in a particular year should be calculated on pre-abolition vacancy position.

The above decision is given as a special case on account of facts that very few Group-"D" employees having requisite qualification are available for consideration and they will lose the opportunity of promotion as direct recruitment quota is not being filled up. This may not be quoted as precedent for other cadres and other categories of posts / services. Once the promotions are given effect, equivalent number of Group-D vacancies at the base-level shall be abolished.
