NOTIFICATION

Bhubaneswar, dated the 18.2.95

No.OSSSC-5/94. 3 5 2 3 /Gen., In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Orissa hereby makes the following rules for regulating the method of recruitment and conditions of service of the Chairman and Members of the Orissa Staff Selection Commission, namely :-

Short title and commencement.

- 1.(1) These rules may be called the Orissa Staff Selection Commission(Method of Recruitment and Conditions of Service of the Chairman and Members) Rules,1995.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Orissa Gazette.

Definitions.

- 2. In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires,-
 - (a) "Commission" means the Orissa Staff Selection Commission constituted under rule 3 of the Orissa Staff Selection Commission Rules,1993;
 - (b) "Member" means a member of the Commission and includes the Chairman thereof;

Method of recruitment to the Post of Chairman and Member.

- 3. (c) "Government" means the Government of Orissa.
- (d) ^{Pay last drawn means the pay drawn last by the person concerned while in Government service or the minimum of the corresponding grade scale of pay, of any of the post last held by him, whichever is higher.}
The posts of Chairman and Member of the Commission shall be filled up by inservice or retired All India Service Officers or State Government Officers or employees of the Public Sector Undertakings or eminent persons in the field of Education and Public Administration:

Provided that on appointment to these posts from amongst inservice Government Officers, such

officers have to voluntary retire from Government service before joining the posts in the Commission.

Tenure of Office of Chairman and Member.

4.(1) The Chairman or Member of the Commission shall hold office for a period of five years or till he attains the age of sixty two years, whichever is earlier.

(2) A person who is appointed as the Chairman or the Member of the Commission shall, on the expiry of his tenure of office, be in-eligible for appointment as Chairman or Member of the Commission.

Pay and Allowances.

5.(1) [The Chairman of the Commission shall receive a pay of rupees ^{Twenty} ~~six~~ thousand ^{Four} ~~five~~ hundred (fixed) per month and the Member of the Commission shall receive a pay of rupees ^{Nineteen} ~~six~~ thousand ^{Five} ~~three~~ hundred (fixed) per month.]

Provided that if a person who after retirement from Government service is appointed as Chairman or a Member and before his retirement was in receipt of a pay more than the amount specified above shall be entitled to draw the pay last drawn by him while he was in Government service:

Provided further that he shall be entitled to draw such pay as will be arrived at after reducing the pay fixed under these rules by the gross amount of pension including any portion of such pension which might have been commuted.

(2) The Chairman or Member shall be entitled to such dearness allowance as sanctioned by the Government from time to time:

Provided that the pay of the Chairman or Member shall be deemed to include the pension, if any, drawn by him in determining the admissibility for dearness allowance but not for the purpose of calculating its amount.

² [Provided also that with effect from 1st day of January, 1996, the Chairman or Member appointed as such will be entitled to such Dearness Allowance as may be notified for this purpose by the State Government from time to time.]

6. The Orissa Civil Service (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1962, the Orissa Service Code, the Orissa Government Servants' Conduct Rules, 1959, Orissa Leave Rules, 1966 and the Orissa Travelling Allowance Rules, 1938 shall mutatis-mutandis be applicable to the Chairman and Member of the Commission.
7. [No pension/gratuity shall be admissible to the Chairman and Member for the services rendered in the Commission.]
8. The medical facilities applicable to Class-I State Civil Service Officers shall be applicable to the Chairman and Member of the Commission.
9. The Chairman and the Member shall be in-eligible to hold any other office under the Government or Public Sector Undertakings or private sector during the tenure of his/her service in the Commission.
10. The Chairman and Member shall be governed by the General Provident Fund (Orissa) Rules, 1938.
11. The Chairman and Member shall be eligible to get either Government accommodation or be entitled to get house rent allowance as admissible to Class-I Officers of the Orissa State Civil Services.
12. The Chairman shall only be entitled to a Sumptuary allowance at the rate of Rs.2000/- per year.
13. The Chairman and Member shall be entitled to get the benefit of Leave Travel Concession as applicable to Class-I State Civil Service Officers.
14. No person -
- (a) who, has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment as Chairman or a Member of the Commission.
