Sub:- Clarification as to "whether in-service Nursing Employees while under in-service study leave can contest in the election of service association for the post of office bearers".

Esteemed Sir,

With due respect and humble submission I beg to draw your kind attention to the following few lines for favor of your sympathetic action keeping in view the larger interest of our association.

That Odisha Nursing Employees' Association is a Govt. recognized association formed with an objective to promote the common service interest of its members and to fulfill requirement of its members relating to service matter.

That members of our association have decided to conduct election in the month of August, 2021 to elect new office bearers for the session 2021-23 and it is seen that some In-service Nursing employees who are prosecuting higher study course at recognized institutions in Odisha under study leave have intended to contest in said election for the post of Office Bearers and a question which is raised that, "whether they are entitled to contest in election of service association for the post of office bearers while under study leave or not?"

That it is pertinent to mention here that though Odisha Nursing Employees Association is an recognized in-service association and all in-service Nursing employees are being empanelled in said association including the Nursing employees who are undergoing higher study course by availing study leave. Such employees are entitled to cast their votes to elect the representatives since they are active members and there is no restriction made in the Bye-Law of association in this regard.

It is therefore requested to intimate the association as to "whether such In-service Nursing employees while undergoing higher study course by availing study leave can also be entitled to submit nominations to contest for the post of office bearers of said association".
