Sub:

Permission to Government servants
to join educational institutions.

The undersigned is directed to invite a reference to Home Department Memo No. 7170(22)-A dated 8.9.51 which states that a Government servant who has not completed 3 years of service under Government should not be permitted to join educational institutions for higher studies. In P & S Department Memo No. 10693(86)-Gen., dated 16.8.1962 Government relaxed the condition of 3 years of service for Government servants who intend to join evening Colleges. A doubt has arisen as to whether for joining morning colleges by Government servants for prosecuting higher studies, the restriction of having put in 3 years of service will be insisted upon. After careful consideration Government have been pleased to decide that Government servants irrespective of the period of service rendered under Government may be permitted to join morning colleges. Permission should not however be given where the Government work is likely to suffer or when class hours overlap duty hours.

The subordinate authorities may be informed of the orders.
