Sub :- Declaring of Survey-Knowing staff as 'Technical'.

Sir,

I am directed to say that consequent upon the decision of Government not to sanction extension of service or re-employment to any superannuated person except some special categories of posts, which have been declared as technical, the practice of granting extension of service or re-employment to persons holding posts that require intimate knowledge in Survey and Land Records has been discontinued. As a result, it has become very difficult to get sufficient number of trained and experienced field staff requiring intimate knowledge in Survey and Land Records. To obviate this difficulty Government have been pleased to order that the posts specified below, which require intimate knowledge of Survey and Land Records should be treated as 'Technical' and persons who have the necessary training and experience may be given re-employment by Government after the age of superannuation upto their 60th year, subject to usual rules of fitness and on annual review.

2. Government have further been pleased to order that in case of the Job-Contract employees of the above mentioned categories in the Department of Land Records and Surveys, who are paid out of contingencies and who do not get any pensionary benefit after their superannuation, there should be no restriction to their employment beyond the age of superannuation and that the appointing authorities will exercise the power of sanctioning the re-employment in terms of G.O.No.6989-R dated 3.6.57.
