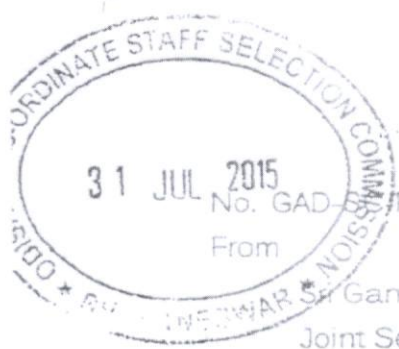

Sub:- Clarification on reservation of vacancies for Women in Public Services.

Sir,

In inviting reference to your Letters No. 2797 dt. 30.05.2015 on the above noted subject, I am directed to say that the reservation of vacancies for women may be determined as per the percentage of reservation indicated in the Odisha Civil Services (Reservation of Vacancies for Women in Public services) Rules,1994 out of the total vacancies reported in a recruitment year, after assessing the vacancies in respect of different categories as per post based reservation. In other words, the number of posts which are reserved would have to be computed in terms of SC,ST and SEBC categories. In such computation, the number of women candidates WILL NOT be added because of the reason that women candidates would be from each of the reserved categories and women candidates could also be from the unreserved category.
