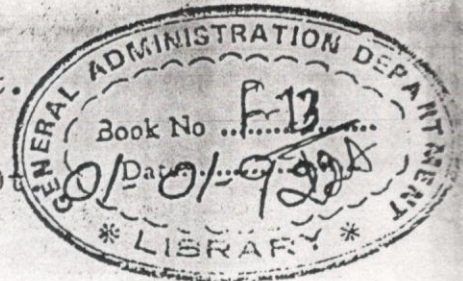

Sub:- Interchangeability of Class-IV Employees
from one category to another.

The undersigned is directed to invite a reference to this Department letter No.1159 dt.13.1.81 wherein the Government have prohibited the interchangeability of Class-IV employees from one category of posts to another. In this letter it was stipulated that a person, on being appointed to any category of Class-IV post, should not be appointed, transferred or posted to another category of Class-IV post belonging to a different cadre. Government, after careful consideration, have decided to order the following in supersession of the aforesaid letter of this Department.

2. While transfer of a person appointed to one category of Class-IV post to another category of Class-IV post belonging to a different cadre is strictly prohibited, there would be no objection to allow a person already appointed to one category of Class-IV post to compete alongwith others for any other category of posts in Class-IV as a fresh appointment. Such permission will be given only if the person concerned satisfies all conditions of eligibility such as age, educational qualification etc. For instance, a person appointed as Chaukidar or Sweeper should be allowed to compete with others for a post of Peon or a Process Sarver. In all such cases of changing the occupation, the person concerned will lose his seniority and he should be treated junior most in the cadre subsequently recruited into.
