



OFFICE MEMORANDUM

At present, most of the cadre Rules contain provision for constitution of Departmental promotion Committee/Selection Board for selection of officers for promotion to Class-I Services/posts in which the Chief Secretary is the Chairman of the Committee/Board. Due to change in the allocation of Departments between the Chief Secretary and Additional Chief Secretary from time to time, it is considered imperative that in the Selection Boards of the respective Departments either the Chief Secretary or the Additional Chief Secretary shall be the Chairmen according to the allocation of Departments among them. Necessary changes may be incorporated in the Service Rules already framed for the purpose at a very early date by amendment.

2. Besides, there are several posts in Class-I for which no statutory service rules have been framed. In such cases, the Departmental promotion Committees/Selection Boards are constituted according to the guidelines given in this Department Office Memorandum No.10280 dt.23.8.83 and subsequent Corrigendum No.315 dt.16.1.87. After careful consideration, it has been decided that the provision for constitution of Departmental Promotion Committees/Selection Boards in such cases shall be modified to the extent that in all cases of promotion to Senior Class-I posts the Departmental Promotion Committee/Selection Board shall be headed by the Chief Secretary or the Additional Chief Secretary as the case may be according to allocation of Departments among them.

This instruction shall, however, not be applicable to Committees constituted under the Rules/instructions issued by Government of India governing any recruitment to the All India Services.
