Sub: Clarification regarding dropping of a proceeding drawn up under O.C.S. (C. C. & A) Rules, 1962 in case of a death of Govt. Servant before conclusion of the proceeding.

In inviting a reference to their letter No. 27298 dt. 26.4.84 on the subject noted above, the undersigned is directed to say that the departmental proceedings drawn up against a Government Servant may be dropped if he dies before finalisation of the same. However the views of the Law Department in this regard is given below.

There is no legal objection to drop the Departmental Proceedings drawn up for defalcation of Government money against a Government Servant who dies before finalisation of the same.

If it can be proved that the legal heirs of the deceased Government servant have inherited any assets acquired by the Government servant with the help of the defalcated money then that can be realised from them.
