RESOLUTION

Bhubaneswar, dated the 21st June 1982

No. 2174/Gen. Government in the erstwhile Political & Services Department Resolution No. 7427/Gen. dated 6.4.1966 had decided that 12½ % vacancies arising in a year in the categories of class III posts just above class IV posts should be filled up by Class IV employees, who have passed at least M.E. School Certificate Examination or an equivalent examination and have rendered not less than five years of service under Government provided they come out successful in a qualifying test prescribed for the purpose. These instructions remained inoperative as it was impracticable to hold selections in the manner prescribed in that resolution. In order to implement the decision of Government properly, it has now been decided that for each Department of Secretariat, the qualifying test will be conducted once a year by a committee consisting of two officers of the rank of Joint Secretary/Deputy Secretary to Government to be nominated by the Secretary of the Department and the Under Secretary/Assistant Secretary in charge of office establishment in the Department. In respect of other offices, the qualifying test will be conducted by a Committee consisting of the officer in charge of the office establishment in the office of the appointing authority and two other Government Officers to be nominated by the appointing authority. The senior most Officer will preside over the meetings of the Committee.

2. The candidates will be subjected to a simple viva voce for testing their intelligence, general knowledge and ability to read and write simple English.
3. It has also been decided that instead of 12½% as prescribed earlier, 33⅓% of the vacancies in these posts should be made available for Class IV employees selected in

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the above manner. Further since the number of vacancies in each Department/Office in a particular year would be small, the vacancies meant for Class IV employees, who qualify in the above manner, shall be earmarked in a continuous roster. Every 3rd vacancy in the roster should be filled up by Class IV employees, who fulfil the above conditions. If the vacancy earmarked for them in this manner is already reserved for SC/ST candidates or for handicapped persons, the next clear vacancy should be earmarked for the Class IV employees, who qualify for the post.

ORDER

Ordered that the Resolution be published in the Orissa Gazette and a copy forwarded to all Departments of Government, Heads of Department, all Revenue Divisional Commissioners, Board of Revenue and District Officers for information.
