Government Order

No. VI Med. - IAM 8/82-2382/dated Bhubaneswar the 30.6.82.

Sub- Declaring the post of Homoeopathic/Unani and Ayurvedic Medical Officers/Demonstrators of Government Homoeopathic Medical College/ Demonstrator of Gopabandhu Ayurvedic Mahavidyalaya, Puri as specially Gazetted.

Indian system of Medicine and Homoeopathy as a method of treatment is as important as any other. It has been the Government's endeavour to strengthen the infrastructural base in order to provide adequate facilities for treatment under these systems. With the above objective in view Government have already established a number of teaching institutions well as Hospitals and Dispensaries in the State. Establishment of more such institutions in a phased manner is also engaging the attention of the Government.

2. With the increase of number of such institutions under Ayurvedic, Homoeopathic and Unani side, there has been persistent demands from the Homoeopathic, Ayurvedic and Unani Medical Officers and Demonstrators of Government Homoeopathic College and Gopabandhu Ayurvedic Mahavidyalaya, Puri to work there on par with their counter-parts in the allopathic side. The Medical Officers of the above three disciplines have also been demanding to accord them the status of Gazetted Officers in the first instance.

3. The question of declaring the posts of Ayurvedic Medical Officers, Homoeopathic Medical Officers, Unani Medical Officers and the Demonstrators of Government Homoeopathic College, Bhubaneswar and Demonstrator of G.A.M., Puri was under active consideration of the Government for some time past. After careful consideration Government have been pleased to decide to declare the above posts specially gazetted under clause(ii) of Rule 17 of the service code read with Rule 9 of the C.C.A. Rules.

This will take effect from the date of issue of the

order.
