NOTIFICATION

Bhubaneswar, the 19th July, 1973

No. Pen-50/73.34325 /F. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Orissa hereby directs that the following amendment shall be made in the Orissa Service Code, namely -

AMENDMENT

In the said Code,

In rule 52 for the word 'twenty-five' the word 'twenty-eight' shall be substituted.

gazetted Government servants in Class-VI, Class-II
or Class-III Service.

(ii) not below twenty SECRETARY TO GOVERNMENT.

Government servants in Class-III service other than Ministerial servants:

(iii) not below eighteen years in the case of non-gazetted class-III Ministerial servants and Class-IV Government servants.

Extracts taken from the Orissa Service Code.

...

52. Except as otherwise expressly provided in rules regulating the methods of recruitment to a particular service or post, a person whose age exceeds twenty-eight years may not be admitted into the service of Government in pensionable service. The State Government, however, may relax this rule in special cases.

52-A Unless otherwise expressly provided by the State Government in any statutory rules the minimum age-limit for entry into Government service shall be as follows:-

- (i) not below twenty-one years in the case of gazetted Government servants in Class-I, Class-II or Class-III Service;
- (ii) not below twenty in the case of non-gazetted Government servants in Class III service other than Ministerial servants;
- (iii) not below eighteen years in the case of non-Gazetted Class III Ministerial servants and Class IV Government servants.
