In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Government of Orissa hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Orissa Ministerial Service (Method of Recruitment and Conditions of Service of Junior Assistant in the Offices of the Departments of Secretariat) Rules, 1951, namely:-

(i) These rules may be called the Orissa Ministerial Service (Method of Recruitment and Condition of Service of Junior Assistant in the Offices of the Departments of Secretariat) (Amendment) Rules, 1982.

(ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Orissa Gazette.

In the Orissa Ministerial Service (Method of Recruitment and Conditions of Service of Junior Assistants in the Offices of the Departments of Secretariat) Rules, 1951 (here-in-after referred to as the said rules) (after) rule 17 the following new rules shall be inserted, namely:-

Rule 17-A Relaxation- when Government are of opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do it may by order for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules in respect of any class or category of persons in public interest".

In the said rules, below rule 18 a new paragraph shall be added as follows:-

"The relative seniority of each candidate recruited in relaxation of normal provisions under rule-17A during a particular year shall be determined with reference to the date of his appointment and such candidates shall take rank just below all other candidates recruited during the same year".

In the said rules:-

(i) In the second proviso to sub-rule (b) of rule 20 the following sentence shall be added at the end namely: The normal upper age limit in case of physically handicapped candidates shall also be relaxed upto ten years".

(ii) In the second proviso to sub-rule (b) of rule 20 the following sentence shall be added at the end namely: The normal upper age limit in case of physically handicapped candidates shall also be relaxed upto ten years".

(ii) for note (i) below the third proviso to rule 20 the following note shall be substituted namely:-

\*(i) All Government Servants whether temporary or on probation or confirmed against substantive posts shall be eligible to appear at the prescribed competitive examination provided they are within the prescribed age limits and otherwise qualified. But those Government employees who have already been appointed substantially or on probation against permanent posts carrying higher scale of pay than that prescribed for Junior Assistants shall not be so eligible to appear at the examination for recruitment under rule 3.

Applications from candidates who are in employment under the Government shall be rejected unless they are submitted through proper channel, provided that advance copies of applications from such candidates shall be entertained subject to their applications being received through the Department in time."

5. In rule 30 of the said rules another paragraph shall be added as follows:-

" Three percent of vacancies arising in each year shall be reserved for direct recruitment in favour of handicapped candidates and shall be filled up in accordance with the instructions issued by Government from time to time in this regard "
