OFFICE ORDER

Dated, Bhubaneswar, the 30.6.01

No. VIA-2/2000 (pt.-II) 12357 /w., In exigencies of public service, the second post of Engineer-in-Chief (Civil) under the administrative control of Works Department was created vide Works Department G.O. No. 29044 Dt. 19.12.1995 upgrading the post of Chief Engineer, Roads with the stipulation that he will continue to exercise the powers of Chief Engineer, Roads until further orders. Considering the multifarious engagements and increasing work load of the Engineer-in-Chief (Civil), Orissa, the question of redistribution of work among the Engineer-in-Chief (Civil) and other Chief Engineers in the (R&E) Cadre was under consideration of Government for sometimes past. After careful consideration and in supersession of all previous instructions issued from time to time, Government have been pleased to regulate the duties and responsibilities of the Engineer-in-Chief (Civil) and Chief Engineers as follows:-

- 1) A Chief Engineer on promotion to the rank of Engineer-in-Chief (Civil) will either continue to exercise the power of the post of Chief Engineer held by him before or be assigned the duty of any post of Chief Engineer as deemed necessary to avoid dislocation of Government works.
- 2) On promotion to the post of Engineer-in-Chief (Civil) he will remain in charge of Establishment of all the employees in the office of Chief Engineer (R&E) and its subordinate offices in addition to the assignment referred to above and any other work as and when assigned by the Government.
- 3) The duties and responsibilities of the post of Chief Engineer, Roads can be assigned to any one of the Chief Engineers in the (R&E) Cadre as will be decided by Government from time to time.

Duties and responsibilities of the Engineer-in-Chief(Civil) and Chief Engineers are detailed below:-

1. E.I.C.(Civil)

- (a) He will remain in charge of establishment of all the employees in the office of the Chief Engineer(R&E), Orissa and its sub-ordinate offices in addition to the assignment that would be allotted to him from time to time.
- (b) General, Monitoring of matters relating to road, building and bridge works of (R&E) Wing.
- (c) Annual Plan review of road and bridge works.
- (d) All other matters not specifically entrusted to the Chief Engineers.
- (e) He will remain in over all charge of entire (R&E) Wing.
- (f) In the matter pertaining to Estt., Tools and Plants, General and monitoring although the Engineer-in-Chief(Civil) will be in over all charge of the (R&E) Wing, he will consult his colleagues i.e. the Chief Engineers concerned, before taking decision on the matter.
- (g) The Engineer-in-Chief(Civil) will hold regular monthly review meeting of all the P.W.D. works under (R&E) wing with concerned Chief Engineers and Superintending Engineers and submit the report to the Government by 15th instant of the succeeding month.

2. Chief Engineer, Roads.

- (a) All matters relating to P.W.D. Roads and Bridges including deposit works and matters connected there with like Budget, Accounts, Letter of Credit etc.
- (b) He will oversee the work of Mechanical wing.

(c) Since Engineer-in-Chief(Civil) remains in over all charge of (R&B) wing, he will consult with him in any matter pertaining to Roads and Bridges i.e. in the matter of Planning Design and monitoring.

3. Chief Engineer, D.P.& I.

(a) The Chief Engineer, D.P.&I. will remain in Charge of Designs Planning and Investigation relating to P.W.D. roads, bridges and buildings and deposit work. The designs and drawings approved by the Chief engineer, D.P.&I. in respect of P.W.D.roads, buildings and bridges are to be signed by the concerned Chief Engineers.

(b) In case of new proposals under plan schemes and NABARD works etc. and monthly progress reports thereof the planning branch will process the matter to the F.I.C.(Civil) through the concerned Chief Engineers for submission to Government in Works Department.

4. Chief Engineer, Buildings.

All matters relating to P.W.D. buildings including deposit works and matters connected therewith like budget, accounts and L.C. etc. He will oversee the works of General Electrical and General Public Health wings.

5. Chief Engineer, Bridges.

All matters relating to flood damaged bridges of Ganjam District executed with World Bank Assistance and matters relating to finalisation of accounts of A.D.E.Project, Crissa, State Road Projects and matter connected therewith, alongwith other externally aided projects except projects relating to National Highways.

6. Chief Engineer, R.D.&P.

All matters relating to research development and quality control.

7. Chief Engineer, National Highways:

All matters relating to National Highways in the State except 4-laning projects under taken with World Bank Assistance and other N.H. Projects those will be specifically placed at the disposal of Chief Engineer, world Bank Projects.

8. Chief Engineer, World Bank Projects.

All matters relating to N.H. 4-Laning Projects undertaken with world bank assistance and projects of similar nature those will be specifically entrusted to him.

Any dispute in the matter of jurisdiction should be referred to Government in works Department for clarification.

These instruction shall be given effect to from the date of issue until further orders.
