No. 8255-Gen.—Whereas Rule-10 of the Orissa Heads of Departments Stenographers Services (Recruitment and Conditions of Services of Private Secretaries, Personal Assistants and Stenographers) Rules, 1988 provides that the candidates for recruitment to the posts of Junior Stenographers shall appear the tests of both English Stenography/Type writing and Oriya Stenography/Type writing as per standard and syllabus set forth in the Appendix ;

And whereas the said standard and syllabus has not yet been prescribed in respect of Oriya Stenography/Type writing in the Appendix ;

And whereas the Stenography/Type writing in Oriya have not been widely taught in the Government recognised and private Institutions for which the candidates have not been able to acquire necessary knowledge of the same ;

And whereas the Director of Examinations under Board of Revenue has conducted tests of stenography and Type writing in English for the Junior Stenographers Recruitment Examination held on the 27th July 1990 and has not been able to conduct the tests of stenography and Type writing in Oriya due to absence of standard and syllabus in the recruitment rules aforesaid ;

Now, therefore, Government on careful consideration of the above aspects of the position have been pleased to relax the provision of tests in Oriya Stenography/Type writing in pursuance of the powers vested with the under rule-24 of the said rules subject to the condition that the concerned Heads of Departments shall be intimated by the Chairman of the Board of Examiners while making allotment of the successful candidates according to their requirement under Rule 13 of the said rules that a stipulation shall be laid in their appointment orders that they shall have to pass a test in Oriya Type writing and Stenography before the end of their normal period of probation and such test shall be conducted by the concerned Head of Department according to the standard to be prescribed in the amendment to be made to the Appendix of the above said Rules and that their services shall be terminated in case they fail to pass the said test.
