Sub:- Expeditious Disposal of C.D.I. cases.

The undersigned is directed to say that the post of Commissioner for Department Inquiries (C.D.I.) was created in G.A. Department during the year 1984 for conducting inquiries in major penalty proceedings initiated against delinquent officers in whose respect Government are the Disciplinary Authority, (of different departments) under (the provisions of) Rule-15 of the O.C.S. (CCA) Rules, 1952. A post of State Representative (SR) was also created in G.A. Department for adducing evidence in support of the charges in all such inquiries before the C.D.I. Departments initiating departmental proceedings against delinquent officers (as above) under the provisions of above Rules may also appoint officers of appropriate rank well conversant with the charges as Additional Presenting Officer in these proceedings before the C.D.I.

It has come to the notice of this Department that old cases since 1998 are pending for disposal before the C.D.I. Quick disposal of cases depend upon the cooperation of the Delinquent Officer, Presenting Officer, Adnl. Presenting Officer, witnesses and production of relevant documents in time. In many cases the above factors create impediments by way of not sticking to the stipulated dates on "frivolous" reasons.

It is, therefore, requested that the Departments of Government shall henceforth issue necessary instructions to all concerned relating to their Department to extend full cooperation as well as production of relevant documents in time to the C.D.I. while referring each cases of major penalty proceedings to the C.D.I. for conducting enquiry into the charges framed against delinquent officers of their Department.

In order to expedite the disposal of year old cases pending with the C.D.I. now, the Departments of Government are further requested to issue separate instructions to all concerned to extend their cooperation.

The above instructions may please be followed scrupulously.
