Instances have come to the notice of Government that sometimes representations are made by some members of the public in matters of postings and transfers of officers at the instance of the officers themselves with a view to their sticking to the posts for their own interest emphasising the ground of their indispensability in the particular posts. Although this is made on behalf of the public, Government are aware that such moves are organised by the officers in many cases. It is further noticed that in some cases the interested persons organise such representations in favour of the officer with a view to getting some undue favour from him. This practice is also harmful to the administration. Postings and transfers are made in the interest of public administration as a whole. Government are of the view that the rising trend in moving Government in matters of postings and transfers of officers should be checked and have, therefore, decided that representations made by outsiders regarding the posting and transfer of an officer should be viewed seriously against the officer concerned and this should be recorded in his character roll and taken into account at the time of his promotion.
