NOTIFICATION

No. 8388—2 R/1-3/95-Gen.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Orissa do hereby make the following rules further to amend the Orissa Ministerial Service (Method of Recruitment and Condition of Service of Junior Assistants in the Offices of the Departments of Secretariat) Rules, 1951 namely:—

1. (1) These rules may be called the Orissa Ministerial Service (Method of Recruitment and Condition of Service of Junior Assistants in the Offices of the Departments of Secretariat) Amendment Rules, 1994.
- (2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the *Orissa Gazette*
2. In the Orissa Ministerial Service (Method of Recruitment and Condition of Service of Junior Assistants in the Offices of the Departments of Secretariat) Rules, 1951 (hereinafter referred to, as the said rules), in rule 2, for clauses (a) and (b) the following clauses shall be substituted, namely:—
 - (a) "Commission" means the Orissa Public Service Commission;
 - (b) "Ex-Servicemen" means a person as defined under rule 2 of the Orissa Ex-Servicemen (Recruitment to State Civil Services and Posts) Rules, 1985."
3. "Year" means the Calendar Year
4. In the said rule, for rule-3, the following rule shall be substituted, namely:—

"3. Recruitment to the service shall be made by means of Competitive Examination to be held ordinarily once in every year. In case requisite number of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribe candidates are not available in the list of successful candidates of such examination for filling up the reserved vacancies, a fresh Competitive Examination may be held only for candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes as the case may be, for filling up the remaining reserved vacancies."
5. In the said rule, for rule 8 the following rule shall be substituted, namely:—

"8. The result of the examination shall be communicated by the Secretary to the Commission to the Government in Home Department before the end of February in the form of a list of successful candidates arranged in order of merit. The list, so prepared by the Commission shall be equal to the number of vacancies notified. The recommendation of the Commission shall remain valid for a period of one year from the date of its approval by Government. The Secretary to Commission shall also send the applications of the successful candidates to the Government in Home Department."
6. In the said rules, for paragraph 2 and 3 of rule 18, the following shall be substituted, namely:—

The relative seniority of the candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe recruited through a special recruitment test under rule 3 shall be determined according to their position assigned in the select list and such candidates shall take rank just below the successful candidates of the preceding general recruitment examination appointment in a particular year.

The relative seniority of the candidates appointed under rule 17-A or under the Orissa Civil Services (Rehabilitation Assistance) Rules, 1990 shall be determined according to their date of appointment and shall take rank below all the successful candidates appointed in a particular year out of the list sponsored by the Commission under rule 8."

7. In the said rules, after second proviso to clause (b) of rule 20, the following proviso shall be added, namely:—

"Provided also that in the case of Women candidates the upper age limit shall be relaxed by five year and in case of Other Backward Class the upper age limit shall be relaxed by three years."

8. In the said rules, for rule 30 including its marginal heading, the following rule and its marginal heading shall be substituted, namely:—

"Reservation of vacancies"—

30. Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, reservation of vacancies for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes, Sportsmen, Ex-Servicemen, Other Backward Class, Physically handicapped and Women shall be as provided under the Orissa Reservation of Vacancies in the Services and Posts (for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes) Act, 1975 and the rules framed thereunder, and under such other relevant rules and orders made by Government from time to time."
