RESOLUTION.

The *23^d* October, 1964.

Subject:- Regularisation of Irregular Recruits
to the posts of Lower Division Assistants
in the Orissa Secretariat.

Recruitment to the posts of Lower Division Assistants in the Orissa Secretariat is to be made under Rule 3 of the Orissa Ministerial Service (Method of Recruitment and Conditions of Service of Lower Division Assistants in the offices of Departments of Secretariat) Rules, 1951. Unfortunately, a large number of Assistants have been appointed in the various Departments of the Secretariat without passing the competitive examination held by the Public Service Commission every year. Some of the Assistants are not even qualified according to rules. Whilst emphasising that any further disobedience of the rules may result in the new recruit losing his service, Government have decided to regularise some of these appointments on certain terms in order to avail of the experience of the personnel. Government have framed rules, namely, the Orissa Ministerial Service (Regularisation of Recruitment and Conditions of Service of Irregular Recruits in the Departments of the Secretariat) Rules, 1964, which has been separately published. All Departments will now regulate the inter-se seniority of the Lower Division Assistants in their Departments according to the new rules with effect from the 1st July, 1964. Promotion has been given to higher grades on the basis of past seniority. All such cases should be reviewed on the basis of the present seniority and subject to the normal rules of promotion, corrections made both as regards seniority amongst the promotees and promotion of those

those who have now received due seniority and are otherwise qualified and demotion of those who, because of falling seniority, will not now qualify for the vacancies that exist. All Departments will complete the examination and finalisation of the revised promotion list before the end of November, 1964.

ORDER.

Ordered that the Resolution should be published in the Orissa Gazette and further ordered that a copy of this Resolution should be forwarded to all Departments of Government in the Secretariat.
