Sub:- Verification of character and antecedents of candidates belonging to other States for appointment under the Government of Orissa.
.....

With reference to their memo. no. VIA-19/64 Pt.-21508/Estt., dated the 7th September, 1964 the undersigned is directed to say that no definite procedure for verification of character and antecedents of candidates belonging to other States for the purpose of appointment under this Government appears to have been laid down. In the absence of the designation and address of the proper authorities in charge of verification of character and antecedents in other States the attestation forms sent to the Chief Secretaries of the concerned State Governments for verification through their appropriate authorities. This procedure of addressing the Chief Secretary in the matter has been objected to by the Government of Andhra Pradesh and they have suggested that when other States or their Heads of Departments etc. want verification of antecedents of candidates belonging to Andhra Pradesh, they have to route their requests through their State - Special Branches, C.I.D. to the Additional Inspector General of Police in-charge of Railways and C.I.D., Hyderabad for necessary action. The suggestion made by the Government of Andhra Pradesh may, therefore, be followed in respect of candidates belonging to that State.

The procedure to be followed in respect of candidates belonging to other States will be communicated as soon as a decision is made in consultation with them. Pending decision in the matter the present practice of addressing the Chief Secretaries of the concerned State Governments by the Administrative Departments may continue.
