RESOLUTION

Dated, Bhubaneswar the 24.6.87.

Sub:- Principle for promotion and fixation of seniority of Ministerial Officers in the office of Heads of Departments.

Review of implementation of the principles outlined in para-3(4) of this Department Resolution No.24/Gen., dt.1.1.85 and the Resolution No.16495/Gen., dt.20.9.86 reveals that the stipulation of eight years of qualifying service for promotion to the posts of Establishment Officers, P.A.(N.T) etc. is likely to cause hardship in the prevalent conditions. Having considered this, Government have been pleased to waive the stipulation of experience of eight years of continuous service occurring in para 3(4) (xi) and para 3(4)(xiii) of the Resolution No.24 dated 1.1.85 and to reduce the stipulated eight years of continuous service to seven years for promotion from the rank of Section Officer Level-II to Section Officer Level-I. The following procedure shall be followed.

1. The post of Section Officer, Level-I shall be filled in from among the Section Officer, Level-II.

(a) No Section Officer, Level-II shall be eligible for consideration unless he has completed seven years of continuous service as such on the 1st day of January of the year in which the Selection Board meets and has passed the final Accounts Examination conducted by the Board of Revenue.

(b) The DPC/Selection Board for promotion to the post of Section Officer Level-I shall be as follows:-

1. Head of the Department- Chairman
2. Addl./Joint Head of Deptt. Member
3. Deputy Secretary of the Administrative Department. Member
4. Deputy Director or any other Class-I Officer in charge of the Establishment. - Secretary

2. Establishment Oriented posts shall be filled up by selections from among the Section Officer, Level-I.

(a) The DPC/Selection Board for promotion to the Establishment oriented posts where the Heads of Department are the appointing authority shall be as in Sub-para - b of para-1 of this Resolution.

(b) In cases where Government are the appointing authority the Selection Board/DPC shall be as follows:-

- i. Secretary/Addl. Secretary to Govt. in the Administrative Department. - Chairman
- ii. Head of Department. Member
- iii. Joint Secretary/Deputy Secy. in charge of the cadre of the Administrative Department. Member
- iv. Deputy Director or any other Class-I Officer in charge of Establishment of the Heads of Department. Secretary

(c) The DPC/ Selection Board in all cases of promotion shall meet in the month of September every year and prepare a list of officers who are selected for the promotions.

(d) Procedure prescribed in para-4 of this Department Resolution No.24/Gen. dt. 1.1.85 shall be followed.

This Resolution shall be effective from the date of issue.
