The undersigned is directed to say that instructions were issued in Home Department Circular No.3434/CC dt.16th January 2001 not to fill up Ex-Cadre posts from among the Senior Assistants who by coincidence are working in Deptts. like Finance Department, Food Supplies and Consumer Welfare Deptt. and Commerce and Transport Department. But it is seen that the practice of recruitment by way of promotion from among Senior Assistants to the posts of Inspector of Commercial Taxes, Supply Inspectors, Traffic Inspectors, Assistant R.T.Os.etc. is still continuing in these Departments.

This breeds avoidable discontent in the cadre, as such opportunity is not available to those Senior Assistants working in Administrative Departments other than in the said three Departments in order to dispel any such disparity and to remove avoidable discontentment in this regard Government orders have been obtained to the effect that concerned Departments are required to amend their respective Recruitment Rules, by 31st December,2002 so as to consider all the Assistants in the Common Cadre of Secretariat for promotion to any such Ex-cadre posts.

Orders of Hon'ble Chief Minister have been obtained in the matter.
