

Principles of promotion of Ministerial Officers in the Offices of Heads of Departments.


The undersigned is directed to refer to his Department letter Nos. 26451 /Gen dated 20.9.90 and 32076 dated 18.8.92 on the above subject in which the Ministerial Officers and Section Officers were given time upto 23.9.92 and 31.12.92 respectively as a last chance to clear the Accounts Examination and to say that it has again come to the notice of the Government that a large number of Ministerial Officers and Section Officers have still not qualified in the Accounts Examination and the employees who are given promotion on adhoc basis during relaxation period are facing reversion with the expiry of the grace period. Possibly because of extension of grace period that has been allowed from time to time, the concerned assistants have not taken the requirement of passing Accounts Examination seriously. Government have again considered the matter and decided (1) to allow last and final extension till 31.12.93 to both the Ministerial Officers and Section Officers with the clear stipulation that a further extension of time would be allowed on expiry of the grace period and those who fail to pass the concerned Accounts Examination would face the consequence of reversion, (2) that Accounts Examinations would be conducted by the Board of Revenue once in a quarter during the extended grace period (3) that each Head of Office should issue a notice to the concerned employees of this decision.

It is requested to take action accordingly.


