After the date of death of the retired Government servant (12.01.2021) there is no scope to revise the Memorandum (4906 Dr. Prasanta Ku Sethi'Page1) issued for drawal of Disciplinary proceedings while he was alive even on the ground of existence of procedural defect .The same must have to be dropped as per the instructions outlined in the G.A. & P.G. Deptt. letter at 19806 Dropping of DP in the event of death of the charged officer 19806 dtd. 21.08.2012'Page1.

However, as regards the instructions in the above letter for realisation of defalcation of Government money, from the legal heirs of the deceased Government servant, when proved, it may be clarified that, as the charges levelled in the Memorandum against Dr. Prasanta Kumar Sethy, Retd., Dy. Director (I.S.M) Directorate of Ayush, Odisha , Ex- DO do not exhibit any defalcation of Government money but shortage of medicines and other articles in the store and stock which only amounts to **misconduct**, the stipulations in the second para of GAD letter at (19806 Dropping of DP in the event of death of the charged officer 19806 dtd. 21.08.2012'Page1.) is not applicable in the instant case. The A/D may consult the Finance Department for regularisation of such shortfalls in the Store and Stock.
