NOTIFICATION

The 26th July 1993

No. 16289—SC-6-28/93-Gen.—In exercise of the powers, conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Orissa hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Orissa Civil Service (Rehabilitation Assistance) Rules, 1990, namely :—

1. (1) These rules may be called the Orissa Civil Service (Rehabilitation Assistance) (Second Amendment) Rules, 1993.
- (2) They shall be deemed to have come into force on the 24th day of September, 1990.

Amendment of the Rule 2 2. In the Orissa Civil Service (Rehabilitation Assistance) Rules, 1990 (hereinafter referred to as the said rules), sub-clause (iv) of clause (b) of rule 2 shall be substituted as follows, namely :—

“(iv) Widowed daughter or daughter in law residing permanently with the affected family, and”

Amendment of the Rule 11 3. In the said rules, for rule 11, the following rule shall be substituted, namely :—

Application of the rule to others.

“11. The facilities provided under these rules shall *mutatis mutandis* be applicable to the families of :—

- (i) Non-Government Primary School Teachers.
- (ii) Teaching and Non-teaching staff of aided Educational Institutions under the Education Department.
- (iii) The work-charged employees of the State Government, and
- (iv) The employees of the Public Sector Undertakings under the State Government.

Insertion of new rule

4. In the said rules, after rule 15, the following rule shall be inserted, namely :—

*16. (1) The State Government where satisfied that the operation of all or any provisions of these rules causes undue hardship in any particular case, it may dispense with or relax the provisions to such extent as it may consider necessary for dealing with the case in a just and equitable manner.

(2) Such cases shall be examined in General Administration Department and Orders of Chief Minister shall be obtained.
