No. 6012—2R/1-27/96-Gen.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Government of Orissa hereby makes the following rule further to amend the Orissa Ministerial Services (Method of Recruitment to the Posts of Junior Clerks in the District Offices) Rules, 1995, namely:—

1. (1) This rule may be called the Orissa Ministerial Services (Method of Recruitment to the Posts of Junior Clerks in the District Offices) Amendment Rules, 1996.
- (2) It shall come into force on the date of its publication in the *Orissa Gazette*.
2. In the Orissa Ministerial Services (Method of Recruitment to the Posts of Junior Clerks in the District Offices) Rules, 1995 after Sub-Rule (3) of Rule 7 the following Sub-Rule shall be inserted, namely:—

“(4) Notwithstanding anything contained in this rule, a Group ‘D’ employee who is not more than forty years of age on the 1st day of April of the year in which recruitment is made and possesses the requisite educational qualifications prescribed in clauses (c) and (g) of Sub-Rule (1) shall be eligible to appear in the competitive examination for recruitment to the Posts of Junior Clerks in the District Offices.”

## ORDER

The 13th March 1997

No. 2174—CA (D)-16/96-CA.—In the meeting of Council of Ministers held on the 27th February 1997, it was decided that 1,775 dwelling units for Government employees at Bhubaneswar over a stretch of land measuring Ac. 58.62 recently resumed from Sairik School, Bhubaneswar would be got constructed by the G. A. Department through Bhubaneswar Development Authority. The total cost of the project is estimated at Rs. 90 crores including Rs. 10 crores as the cost of the land. B. D. A. is to raise Rs. 60 crores from financing institutions. The margin money would be Rs. 30 crores including Rs. 10 crores towards cost of the land.

In order to supervise successful implementation of the project a Steering Committee has been constituted by the Council with the following as Members.

- (1) Special Secretary to Government, G. A. Department.
- (2) Engineer-in-Chief-cum-Secretary to Government, Works Department.
- (3) Commissioner-cum-Secretary, H. & U. D. Department.
- (4) Vice-Chairman, B. D. A., Bhubaneswar
- (5) A representative of the Finance Department
- (6) The Committee can co-opt any technical members as and when required.

Examination and approval of Plans, Designs, Specifications, Estimates, etc. would be the responsibility of the Steering Committee.

The Steering Committee would also decide pre-qualified tenders, competitive tenders and approve the tenders, supervise the works during execution to ensure quality and timely completion of the project.
